Ferradermis Robotics Activity Letter Criteria

Students who are on the robotics team will be able to earn a letter, bars, and pins using our points based system. The points are related to the amount of time spent and responsibility demonstrated to both the team and the robotics community. A minimum attendance requirement of 60 hours will need to be met between the beginning of school and the end of Championships.

- ★ Sub Team Lead or Team Captain (10 points per year)
- ★ Member of Drive Team, Safety Captain, or Head Scout for any In-Season Event (5 points per event)
- ★ Member of Drive Team for any off-Season Event (3 points per event)
- ★ Participation in a Regional Event (4 points per event)
- ★ Impact Presenter (5 points per event, 3 points for understudy)
- ★ Participation in World Championships (5 points)
- ★ Participation in a Pre-Season or Off-Season Competition (2 points per event)
- ★ Animation Award Submissions (2 points per animation)
- ★ Ambassador at Regional or World Event (2 points per event)
- ★ Participation in a Community Event (a parade, presentation, FLL competition volunteer,...) (1 point per event)
- ★ Participation in Kick Off (1 point per year)
- ★ Dean's List Nominee (3 points)
- ★ Mentor FLL Team (every 10 hrs = 2 points)
- ★ Extra Activities at the Discretion of Head Mentors (1 point each)
- ★ Every additional 20 hours over the mandatory 60 hours (1 point each)
- A season pin is earned each year by participating in a Regional or World event.
- A letter and bar will be awarded after 32 points are earned in a single year. Seniors in their 4th year may be awarded a letter at the discretion of the head mentors.
- After receiving a letter, each year a student obtains 45 points, an additional bar will be earned.
- > Points will reset at the end of each season.
- > Team Captains will receive a Captain's Pin.
